## Master's Degree in Christian Counseling

### Program Description

The Christian Counseling program is a graduate program that integrates biblical truth, theological reflection, and professional counseling principles to prepare students for Christ-centered emotional and spiritual care. Designed for those who feel called to serve in churches, Christian organizations, or faith-based agencies, the program emphasizes both a solid theological foundation and the development of applied therapeutic skills. Students acquire competencies to offer wise, ethical, and spiritually sensitive guidance, understanding the human experience from a perspective that unites psychology, theology, and pastoral practice.

### Program Objective

To train students to offer compassionate, biblically grounded, and clinically responsible counseling rooted in a Christian worldview. The program prepares participants to address emotional, relational, and spiritual challenges through integrative approaches that combine biblical wisdom, psychological theory, and pastoral care. Its goal is to develop counselors capable of supporting processes of healing, restoration, and spiritual growth in diverse ministry and community settings.
